### **Essential Functions**

Carpenters are classified in various levels according to their skills. The following is representative of the tasks performed by laborers on construction sites. The construction carpenter may perform some or all of the following tasks, depending upon which level they are assigned.

- Operates hand and power tools to construct structures using wood, steel, concrete and other building materials.
- Prepares for concrete pours, ties rebar, operates vibrator during concrete pours, strips and cleans forms after concrete pours.
- Assists in rigging boom truck for concrete tilt ups and steel placement. Assists in placing, leveling and bracing concrete tilt walls.
- Uses shovels, rakes and other manual means to dig trenches, level forms, etc.
- Sacks, patches and grouts concrete walls.
- Loads and unloads or fetches materials using a reach forklift.
- Uses gas torch to cut steel.
- Acts as roof monitor when fall protection system is being employed.
- Operates laser level to install piping, level forms, assist with site excavation.
- Inspects jobsite for safety issues and reports them to superintendent or correct him/herself. Examples of these tasks include removing and/or repairing worn electrical cords, constructing walking ramps, placing rebar caps and barricading ditches.
- Performs site clean up and keeps job trailer and tool trailer clean and orderly.

### **Peripheral Functions**

Runs errands to collect equipment and supplies or visit the home office.

### **Skills, Knowledge and Abilities**

- Has a positive attitude, initiative and a willingness to learn.
- Ability to maintain a good attendance record.
- Ability to operate hand and power tools commonly employed on construction sites.
- Ability to operate equipment and machinery commonly employed on construction sites.
- Knowledge of the construction techniques used to build commercial and industrial buildings.
- Knowledge of the safety requirements for a construction site.

### **Physical Requirements**
